

LD Test Selection Committee Rules for Removing Tests From Estimator

Achievement tests should be removed from the Estimator program when:

- A test, as determined by the copyright date, is more than 15 years old, or
- A new version of the test was published more than two years ago.

Aptitude (IQ) tests should be removed from the Estimator program when:

- A test, as determined by the copyright date, is more than 15 years old, or
- A new version of the test was published more than four years ago.

Removal Procedures

- In January of each year a list of tests to be removed will be published.
- Test on the list published in January will be removed in December.

These procedures are designed to allow LEAs to budget for and purchase new tests as necessary.
